Child & Adolescent Services

Child & Adolescent Outpatient Services

Child and adolescent outpatient counseling is offered at a number of GLRC's Outpatient Services locations across the Upper Peninsula. Clinicians provide treatment of mental health disorders, substance use disorders, and co-occurring disorders.

Clinicians that work with children and adolescents are specialized in the treatment of childhood trauma and hold various specialty certifications in modalities such as Trauma-Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy, Intergenerational Trauma and Neuro-Developmental Trauma, Eye Movement Desensitization and Reprocessing (EMDR). Many clinicians also are are Certified Advanced Alcohol and Drug Counselors.

Child & Adolescent Psychiatric Specialty Clinic
GLRC established the Child & Adolescent Psychiatric
Specialty Clinic to help address the unmet need for
psychiatric mental health services for children and
adolescents. GLRC has partnered with Pine Rest
Christian Mental Health Services to provide psychiatric
oversight. Effectively addressing adverse childhood
experiences and mental health issues is vital for
children so they can continue to grow and reach their
full potential. The Child & Adolescent Psychiatric
Specialty Clinic will help individuals utilize many
different pathways to find their own personal path to
healing. Services available through the clinic are:
medication management, parent education, psychiatric
evaulations, collaboration with community providers,

and coordination of care

ESM Trauma Assessments

GLRC, in partnership with EasterSeals MORC, provides comprehensive neuro-developmental trauma assessments for children and adolescents throughout the Upper Peninsula. This assessment model is designed to screen and assess for the impact that exposure to complex trauma or toxic stress has on a child or adolescent. This highly specialized program is designed for those children and adolescents who experience developmental delays as a result of traumatic experiences.

Adolescent Services Center

GLRC's Adolescent Services Center is a 16-bed residential treatment facility for youth ages 12 to 17 with substance use disorder. Clients reside in semi-private rooms, participate in many hours of therapy each day and take part in on-site schooling.

Youth Over 14

Individuals seeking mental health treatment over the age of 14 are eligible under the Minor Confidentiality Agreement to be seen without parental consent a limited amount of time.

Great Lakes Recovery Centers is licensed by the State of Michigan and accredited by CARF (Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities). GLRC is also HIPAA (Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act) compliant. GLRC actively protects the confidentiality and privacy of their clients.

Foster Care

GLRC's MDHHS Regional Resource Team provides information about becoming a foster parent, supports current foster parents, and provides comprehensive training for those interested in becoming foster parents. For more information call (920) 517-8733.

Medical Services
