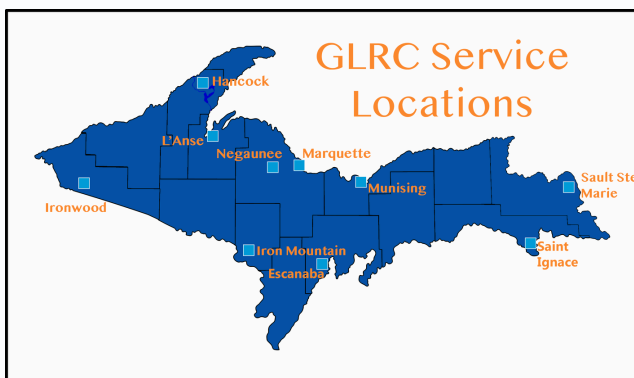

Other Services

GLRC offers a wide variety of behavioral health services across our locations. Other services provided by the agency include:

Women and Families Services provides specialized services for pregnant clients and mothers with dependent children. We provide counseling to women and families as well as potentially helping to find resources regarding financial assistance for housing, qualified child care providers, food, clothing, and miscellaneous expenses incurred while receiving treatment. Specially furnished suites accommodate clients with dependent children (up to age 11). During the academic year, busses transport clients' school-age children to and from school and on-site care is provided for younger children while their mothers are in groups.

Child & Adolescent Psychiatric Specialty Clinic

GLRC established the Child & Adolescent Psychiatric Specialty Clinic to help address the unmet need for psychiatric and specialty mental health services for children and families. GLRC believes that effectively addressing adverse childhood experiences and mental health issues requires access to a full spectrum of services including psychiatric care, specialty assessments with treatment services and clinicians specially trained in trauma, childhood development, and family systems.

Referrals

We work to connect clients with necessary services, including OB/GYN and pediatric referrals, WIC, DHHS, vocational services, and more. Other services available include transportation, life skills support services, referrals to community agencies that provide employment, education, housing, and medical related services.

Medical Services

GLRC Medical Services are available to the general public and offered in a variety of locations throughout the Upper Peninsula. These programs are staffed by a physician and nurse practitioners who can provide medication assisted treatment along with treatment for health conditions, preventative care, education on health topics and minor office procedures. GLRC's Negaunee Integrated Care Clinic offers medical services for both women and children. Our services include minor injury and illness, routine physicals, Women's health, family practice, family planning, dermatology, Hepatitis C treatment, Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT), and ostomy care. Foster Care

GLRC's MDHHS Regional Resource Team provides information about becoming a foster parent, supports current foster parents, and provides comprehensive training for those interested in becoming foster parents. For more information call (920) 517-8733.

OS Reentry Services

Peer Recovery Services

ESM Trauma Assessments

Child & Adolescent Specialty Services provides comprehensive neuro-developmental trauma assessment services to children and adolescents throughout the UP. This assessment model is designed to screen and assess for the impact that exposure to complex trauma or toxic stress has on a child.

Prevention Services

GLRC facilitates both substance abuse and suicide prevention programming throughout the UP. Prevention Specialists go into the community to offer evidence-based programming to schools, courts, CPS, and businesses.

Veterans Services

GLRC provides readjustment counseling services and a specialized group for veterans in the community as well as MAT. GLRC also works closely with the VA to provide homeless veterans with a place to stay. For more information call (906) 485-2347.
